- 3) To help them generate income by practicing Recycling used garments.


IV.METHODOLOGY


Q:1 how do you discard or re-use the used garments

A) duster B) mops C) doormats D) Others




Q:2 Which one is the choice of your garment made by recycling?


(A)Western B)Traditional C) Indo-western
